### Student Receives Prestigious Furst Award

The American College of Toxicology (ACT) presented the Furst Award to graduate student Gerald C. Llewellyn of the Medical College of Virginia for the 97/98 school year. Gerald was recognized for his in-depth poster presentation on his research of the toxic mold Patulin on the immune system's B-cells and T-cells. The award was named in honor of Dr. Arthur Furst, a founder and former



president of the 15-year-old ACT. Dr. Furst is the only toxicologist in the 800-member society honored in this way!
